

## **Cookie Policy**

### **Information about cookies**

Due to the coming into force of the Law for the Services of the Information Society (LSSICE) established by Royal Decree 13/2012, it is necessary to obtain the express consent of the users of all web pages containing persistent cookies before browsing them.

### **What are cookies?**

Cookies and other similar technologies such as local shared objects, flash cookies or pixels, are tools used by web servers to store and retrieve information on their visitors, in addition to contributing to the proper functioning of the site.

By using these devices, the web server is able to recall certain information related to the user, such as their web page preferences, name and password, products they are interested in, etc.

### **Cookies accepted and excluded under the regulation**

According to the EU directive, the prior informed consent of the user is required for cookies used for analytical, marketing or ad affiliation purposes. Technical cookies or those necessary for the functioning of the web page or the provision of services expressly requested by the user remain exempt.

## **Information about the cookies used**
